<u>Events</u> – host prevention, education, awareness events. MOPSI –grants available for any evidence based prevention programs for educational speakers or any prevention work of any kind.

Priority is to Recruit New Members- map community groups to solicit to join our force. Need to actively get the word out we need new members: advertise in the Chronicle, announce at televised Selectmen meetings, use local Cable network, electronic sign in town center, word of mouth.

Suggestions for events/committee activities:

Prescription take back events – pair with other events

Utilize local cable Access station to broadcast events and information

Connect with Senior Center-get their support- geriatric issue with medications, many grandparents caring for grandchildren because their children have issues with use disorders.
