The Board of Selectmen in the TOWN OF MILLBURY will hold a Public Hearing via Zoom.com on August 12, 2021 at 6 PM at the Municipal Office Building, 127 Elm Street to act upon the Petition of the Massachusetts Electric Company d/b/a National Grid Of NORTH ANDOVER, MASSACHUSETTS respectfully represents the Massachusetts Electric Company d/b/a National Grid of NorthAndover, Massachusetts, that it desires to construct a line of underground electric conduits, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, under and across the public way or ways hereinafter named. Wherefore it prays that after due notice and hearing as provided by law, it be granted permission to excavate the public highways and to run and maintain underground electric conduits, together with such sustaining and protecting fixtures as it may find necessary for the transmission of electricity, said underground conduits to be located substantially in accordance with the plan filed herewith marked- Latti Farm Road - Millbury - Massachusetts. The following are the streets and highways referred to: Plan number# 29847142 Latti Farm Road - National Grid to install beginning at a point approximately 1000 feet southeast of the centerline of the intersection of Southwest Cutoff and continuing approximately 835' feet in a southwest direction. Installing two mid size manholes and approximately 835' of conduits on Town Right of Way.


