He reviewed the Millbury water system schematic, reviewed the system of delivery, Recent Capital Projects, Water Main Replacement, Millbury Ave WTP Valves, Phase II SCADA, 2020 Capital Planning, Town Center Water Main Replacement, MRAM Mains, New Chemical Feed Pumps.

Paul Lawson reviewed Operational Highlights 2019 which includes Leak Detection Survey, Water Main Breaks, Customer Conservation Program, Distribution System flushing/Cleaning, and NEWWA Hydrant Competition. He also spoke about 2020 Operational Planning which
