47 Manor Road – Make repairs to a shoreline retaining wall

Justin explained to the members the key on the plans. He said the wall will be approximately 3 ½ feet tall on a concrete footing with crushed stone behind it. Paul asked if the water line was down yet. Ed said it is going down slowly due to all the rain we have been getting. Justin said erosion controls will be put in place. Tony asked if the new wall will be further into the pond. Justin said the new wall will be on the same line as the old wall. Justin said it will be rough and be on an angle. Ron asked what equipment will be used. Justin said the old wall will be demoed by hand and no heavy equipment will be used. Tony made a motion to close the hearing; Paul seconded; voted unanimously.

Justin Newton was present with the homeowner. He said materials have been moved until all permits have been properly pulled. Justin said crushed stone will be used for drainage. Paul asked if the piles are surrounded by wattles. Justin said yes. Paul made a motion for a negative determination; Tony seconded; voted unanimously.

5-9 Latti Farm Road – Demolition of an existing building and the construction of a 54,300 s.f. cannabis cultivation and manufacturing facility

Steven Chouinard from vhb was present for the applicant. Steve said a DEP file number has been issued and the changes reflect the comments from them. He said the front of the

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building has been bumped out a bit and will be the main entrance. Since the last meeting sidewalks have been added. The parking in front went from 21 to 17 spaces. DEP's comment about an existing detention basin was concern with output. Steven said there is no riprap but they are completely stabilized and will not be changed. He said he found a lot of trash in them and they will be cleaned out by hand. Steven said the Town Planner has made some comments also. He said a berm will be cleaned up that is eroding. He said an existing driveway will be dug up and new pavement will be added. The plans now reflect what DEP had issues with. Steve said the developer is willing to put in the wetland signs the commission asked for. An 8 foot chain-link fence will surround the building and the signs can be put on it. Tony asked where the snow storage will go. Steve said there are areas designated for it and if the piles get too big it will be trucked off site. Tony asked if there was a maintenance plan. Steve said yes, it was in the NOI. Paul made a motion to close the hearing; Tony seconded; voted unanimously.
