58 Oak Pond Ave - Construction of water maintenance facility

Whitney Street Home Builders

17 Rice Road - Construction of condominium development

No DEP number has been issued to date. James Tetreault from Whitney St Home Builders gave an update on the changes. A second road access was added to development to facilitate vehicular movement; all grades will stay the same as on original plan. The unit closet to the pond was removed from the plan. The buildings will follow Stormwater regulations for infiltration. Additional parking spots were added to the project design. No wetland resource area disturbances are included in the design. Several abutters shared their comments- Cody Matthews of 6 Rice Road, stated he thought the abutters were asking for 6 units to be removed, but only 2 had been removed. Olivia Matthews, 11 Rice Road, said she had emailed a letter to be given to the Commission members for their review. A motion was made to continue the hearing to the next meeting by Ray, seconded by Chris, all in favor- Unanimous.

Robert Fields

1548 Grafton Street – Installation of gas line

Mr. Fields described the project as an installation by Eversource to run a natural gas line from the road down his gravel driveway to his house. The house is within the 100' buffer zone. He described it

as a 1-day project with no stockpiling of materials. A motion for a Negative Determination was made by Paul, seconded by Ray, all in favor- Unanimous.

Public Meeting-Amended OOC

NextGrid Colton, LLC

Colton Road Extension- Minor Modifications to Approved OOC

Patrick Johnson represent the applicant. The utility company has made some changes regarding some clearing and pole moves. The Commission requested that wetland signs be placed in the parking area. The applicant explained that there will be some drainage improvements, utility changes underground, and wires to be placed under ground. They further explained that no homes are planned for this project. The original OOC was approved in July 2020. A description of the changes to the project were made and they will be minor. A motion to approve an Amended OOC was made by Ray, seconded by Chris, all in favor- Unanimous.
