-We are still waiting on the decision for the amount of money we will have for grant for the next year, we do have around \$800 in unclaimed money from last year that we are able to roll into our grant.

Jen had emailed ArtReach several times with no response about our ideas of Fall art workshops with the school, at this point we are too late to be able to do any kind of Fall classes for the school this year. Do we want to plan for a Spring class? Look at possibly other services for the schools? With the upcoming grant process we decided we do not have the time to plan for a Spring program. We can possibly reach to out Pozzi and see if he wants to do some type of after school program, or look into a full week Summer Camp or a 3-4 week camp with a 2 day attendance.

We could plan to put on an event at the Asa Waters, Linda knows someone who wants to be able to put on a slideshow of photography, do we have to Sponsor the event or put it on to be able to use the space as a free venue?

Jeff Coons emailed about the possibility of using the grant money towards other things for his films as he was unable to submit his film to any festivals. We will discuss the possibility of him doing a showing in town for his video, or having something related in town, or we may have to deny the grant.

Cake Shop Cafe wants to take over the art gallery shows as they do not want to be open late for future showings. Does the Council still want to try to plan shows on weekends? We think we will let the Cafe take the reigns for future shows. We will try to think of other local places that we can try to do some kind of event, and try to partner with businesses for donations on possible future events.

Maegan will contact IBA for rack cards and business cards (logo, email), upload the rack card designs to the Google Drive.

Do we want to do a Chain of Lights Event? Sell "featured artist" Christmas cards. Painting town common where they have the lights. Sell the cards with proceeds to MCC. Convert painting to an outline for kids coloring sheets.
