Jen O'Connell: Are we in an audit now?

Katie McKenna: They are in now. I hope to have it done before I leave. I normally work on setting the tax rate once the audit is done. Budget sheets are usually sent out on December 1st and are due back to the Town Manager by December 31st. I am not sure how that will work this year. You will need to roll over the funds for the roads from FY16 at the next Town Meeting or it will go back to the General Fund and then into Free Cash.

Katie McKenna: There is an interim person for my position until the position is filled. Jen O'Connell: I am thinking of a combined meeting between the Finance Committee, Board of Selectmen and the School Committee at the start of the budget process. I feel that this is essential in the process.

Katie McKenna: You should have an understanding before the contract negotiations start. You should also look into in-house payroll.
