- Director Search Subcommittee
  - o Keeping at this time. Likely will move to dissolve at next meeting.
- Facilities Subcommittee
  - No Updates.
- Technology Subcommittee

- Other Subcommittees?
  - Jeff Raymond called other Trustees to bring up the formation of any new subcommittees as they deem appropriate.
  - New possible subcommittee on One Town One Book program.

#### **New Business:**

- Printers
  - o Two new printers were installed and are currently in working order.
- Computers
  - o All staff received new computers through WorldBand.

- We are waiting on four additional laptops (two for staff use and two for public use, while in Library).
- o Trustees discussed the searching for computer/technology grants/programs.
- Interviews for Library Page
  - The Library is hiring a new part-time Page.
  - Interviews were conducted and an offer letter we sent to a candidate.
- Horizon Solutions
  - Horizon Solutions will come to the Library to replace emergency lighting to more energy efficient LED lights. This is paid for through a municipal grant.
- Custodial
  - As of July 1<sup>st</sup> the Library custodial staff will be transitioned to the town-wide shard service. We have requested to keep our same staffer with additional hours on Fridays. This will be discussed at the next department meeting.
- Charter Review proposed language
  - Jeff Raymond has represented the Library at the town-wide Charter Review Committee. He asked the board to review proposed changes (see attached proposed changes to Town Charter language).
  - Jeff motioned for the board to support these changes a written, seconded by Christine Brady, approved unanimously.
- MPC
  - Trane is no longer guaranteeing coils for heating equipment. This may incur additional cost to the Library. MPC is working hard to resolve this with Trane.
  - As this may be a contractual issue, and we will bring in the Town Manager if needed.
- Disney VHS Tapes
  - Trustees had a discussion on what to do if donations of media to the Library holds potential significant value. Example to donated sealed VHS tapes was used.
  - The board decided that these situations should be deferred to the Friends of the Millbury Public Library.
- Friends Meeting
  - o The next Friends of the Millbury Public Library meeting is on June 25th, 2019.
- Technology Subcommittee will be looking into the T-Mobile Hot Spots as they are still not working. Since they have not been used we will attempt to have monthly fee reimbursed for inactive period.

#### Old Business:

  - o This item is tabled until the new Director starts.
- Deep Freeze
  - Discussed the alternative "Reboot/Restore." After discussion we will likely keep
    Deep Freeze as it is more secure. Additional research may be needed on price.

  - Summer Reading Kickoff is June 19th. Students have already signed up.
- Library Hours
