- All lighting has been replaced except for the reading room upstairs. The original grant did not include the reading room, so the library will have to fund replacing the bulbs.
   The new bulbs would cost approximately \$500 total. Library received a Mass Saves grant for the bulbs, which brought total cost down to \$178.

 Ann had all four of job seeker presentations. 26 patrons participated. Ann recorded 3 of the presentations and put them on the Library's social media pages.
