The Millbury Public Library was one of 517 public libraries nationally that received \$3,000 from the American Library Association - Libraries Transforming Communities: Focus on Small and Rural Libraries grant. The eligibility for this grant was limited to communities with populations less than 25,000 according to the Institute of Museum and Library Services definitions. This funding will enable our library to lead community engagement programs for patrons and library staff. "Through community engagement, my goal is to gather feedback from the community on how to continue to offer innovative library programs despite the challenges of limited funding, staff development to stay abreast with new library trends, and be able to have staff stay stress-free through fun engaging staff development workshops" said Ann Dallair, Library Director.

This program's purpose is to gather feedback from the community to identify opportunities to hear ideas and suggestions on future innovative programs, programs that worked/not worked, ways for promotion, and staff development that can be offered here.
