# 1. Call to Order

Bruce DeVault called the meeting to order @ 7:00 PM.

# 2. Update - ZAP 50 & Aug 27th Bike Way Project, Blackstone Watershed

Ray Kelley stated that the joint venture between the Committee and ZAP 50, which included the cleanup on August 27th, was a success. The Committee volunteer group spent 4 hours trimming and picking up trash. There was a lot of trimming to do along the Bikeway trail. The volunteer group filled a 4 x 8 low profile trailer with 25 bags of trash tires & a shopping cart. The DPW was kind enough to pick up the trash from our venture the following Monday.

Overall, the Committee played an important role in planning and implementation in ZAP 50, which spanned from Worcester MA, to Providence RI, with more than 2000 people involved. It was a great success.

<u>Ray Kelley</u> also mentioned that we should stay in touch with the Blackstone Watershed Collaborative and other local organizations that were involved with ZAP 50 for the future because many of their goals/activities and the Committee's align, so we can continue to work together and support each other.

Bruce DeVault had mentioned, that because of the Blackstone Bikeway venture, we had gained 30 plus Facebook members.

<u>Michele Piselli</u> mentioned the change that was made for Facebook members to join. <u>Ray Kelley</u> stated that the change was to have all members be accepted by one of the admins to try to control advertising on the page.

Jim Sauriol recommended putting the kiosk closer to the trail head instead of where they were planned to be located before.

For Brierly Pond, the Committee had an in-depth conversation on this conservation area regarding what needs to be done. **Bruce DeVault** also mentioned that the bike riders are doing a lot of reconditioning. He had gotten word that they had around eight miles of trails reconditioned already.

<u>Bruce DeVault</u> reported the Rail Trail is for the most part in ok condition. The part that needs volunteer work is from the Windle Field area to Gover Road. The Lions Club will be asked to help with this section like they helped with the other side.

# 6. Update - Equipment trailer

Bruce DeVault told the Committee that the trailer is all setup except for the solar panels. Ray Kelley made a motion to approve the solar panel purchase of approximately \$500.00, and Michele Piselli seconded the motion. Bruce DeVault took a vote, and it was unanimous.
