Working with the Town, the Pare Corporation has submitted an application in response to RER ENV 14 POL 01 Dam, Levee, and Coastal Infrastructure Repair and Removal Program to the Office of Energy and Environmental Affairs to rehabilitate the Dam.

The Ramshorn Pond Dam in Millbury provides a significant environmental and recreational resource to the surrounding community, but is in desperate need of repair. Ramshorn Pond is a state listed Great Pond, however it is currently considered to be in poor condition and the Town received a Certificate of Non-Compliance and Dam Safety Order to repair or remove the Dam.
