2. Report of the Administration

a. Welcome and Introduction of Administrative Team and New Faculty

Mrs. Friedman introduced the new faculty members at the Raymond E. Shaw Elementary School: Eric Gervais, Technology Teacher, Tamar Lasri, Adjustment Counselor, Mary-Ellen Savickas, Special Education Teacher, and Olivia Padgett, Long Term Sub for grade 4.

Mr. Hall introduced the new faculty members at the Elmwood Street School: Susan Lewis, ESL Teacher, Victoria Sutphen, Kindergarten Teacher, and Jennifer Farrington, Long Term Sub for grade 2.

Mrs. Bennett introduced the new faculty members at the Millbury Jr./Sr. High School: Julie Almstrom, Special Education Teacher, Jesse Dooley, Music Teacher, Lauren Hinchey, Math Teacher, Julia Knowles, French Teacher, Ryan Lavigne, Art Teacher, Edris Logue, French Teacher, MaryBeth Melanson, Special Education Teacher, and Kelsey Whelpley, Physical Education/Wellness Teacher.

Ms. Ryan introduced district-wide new faculty members: Rose Mahoney, BCBA, and Annmarie Choque, Special Education Team Chair for both Elmwood and Shaw Schools.

b. Opening Day Update

Mr. Myers stated that the first two weeks of school have been very successful! He stated that the faculty and staff were welcomed by Senior Class President, Dan Fuentes, and Vice President Sydney Moore. Mr. Myers stated that the faculty and staff also enjoyed a presentation by Tara Martin, author of *Be REAL*: *Educate from the Heart*.

Mr. Myers stated that students in grades 1-12 started school on August 29th and kindergarten students stared on August 30th.

c. State Primary Voting

Mr. Myers stated that the gym in the jr. /sr. high school was used as Millbury's polling station for the September 4th State primary. He also stated that of the Town's 9,340 registered voters 1,40l (15%) cast a ballot in the State's primary election. The voting process was very well coordinated and managed thanks to Jayne Davolio.

Mr. Bedard stated that he had rode on buses for the first few days of school and there were a few issues. He stated that bus 7 was running late from the first day. He stated that they made some adjustments by beginning pick-ups 10 minutes earlier for the high school and Shaw School. He stated that he would continue monitoring the bus route and all changes will be posted on the website
