FY 2020 CDBG Hearing

The Millbury Board of Selectmen will conduct a Public Hearing during its scheduled meeting on Tuesday, August 9, 2022 at 6:00 PM at the Millbury Municipal Office Building, 127 Elm Street, Selectmen's Meeting Room.

The hearing will review the status of projects funded through Millbury's joint FY 2020 Community Development Block Grant, in partnership with the Town of Dudley, a \$664,500 award, including 1) engineering design for public works infrastructure improvements in a predominantly residential neighborhood on Pearl Street and northern Maple Street in Millbury; 2) architectural design at the Millbury Senior Center for repairs to roof insulation and limited disabled access improvements; and 3) a housing rehabilitation program for eligible low-to-moderate income residents in Millbury and Dudley. A potential grant amendment to transfer uncommitted or unused architectural design, engineering design, housing rehabilitation and/or administrative funds for use with construction of infrastructure improvements on Pearl Street (primarily funded through FY 2021 CDBG funds) will also be discussed.

The Central Massachusetts Regional Planning Commission (CMRPC) provides grant administration and project management assistance to the Town of Millbury.
