Public Hearing

PH-1 In conformity with the requirements of Section 22 of Chapter 166 of the Massachusetts General Laws, you are hereby notified that a public hearing will be held in the Millbury Town Hall, 127 Elm Street, Millbury on **Tuesday, April 9, 2024 at 6 PM** on the Petition Massachusetts Electric company dba NATIONAL GRID and Verizon New England requests permission to locate poles, wires, and fixtures, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, along and across the following public way:

Providence St - National Grid to install 9 JO Poles on Providence St beginning at a point approximately 450 feet southeast of the centerline of the intersection of Riverlin St and Providence St and continuing approximately 4500 feet in a southeast direction. Installing P 11-50, P 12-50, P 14-50, P 15-50, P 27, P 27-50, P 33-50, P 45, P 48-50.

Providence St - National Grid to install beginning at a point approximately 450 feet southeast of the centerline of the intersection of Riverlin St and Providence St and continuing approximately 4500' feet in a southeast direction. Install MH 5558, MH 5559, MH 5560, MH 5561, MH 5562, MH 5563, MH 5564, MH 5565.

Grafton St - National Grid to install 4 JO Poles on Grafton St beginning at a point approximately 60 feet west of the centerline of the intersection of Carousel Dr & Grafton St and continuing approximately 1100 feet in a west direction. Installing P 10-50, P 10, P 8-50, P 7-50.

Grafton St - National Grid to install beginning at a point approximately 60 feet west of the centerline of the intersection of Carousel Dr & Grafton St and continuing approximately 240' feet in a westerly direction. Install MH 5557. Install 343' of conduit from P 8, P 8-50 to MH 5557, P 10, P 10-50.

Riverlin St - National Grid to install 1 JO Pole on Riverlin St beginning at a point approximately 125 feet north of the centerline of the intersection of Grafton St and Riverlin St and continuing approximately 0 feet in a southerly direction. Installing P 0-50.

Riverlin St - National Grid to install 1 SO Pole on Riverlin St beginning at a point approximately 350 feet south of the centerline of the intersection of Grafton St and Riverlin St and continuing approximately 0 feet in a south direction. Install P 1-50.

Grafton St - National Grid to install 1 JO Pole on Grafton St beginning at a point approximately 280 feet east of the centerline of the intersection of Pleasant Hill Dr. and Grafton St. Installing Pole 52-50 in public way along with 1-3" conduit to loop in URD at Autumn Gates Circle.

Greenwood St - National Grid to Relocate 1 JO Pole on Greenwood St beginning at a point approximately 155 feet north of the centerline of the intersection of Tainter Hill Rd and continuing approximately 15 feet in an easterly direction . National Grid is relocating (with a new 40 class 2 pole) P-42. The new location of P-42 will allow us to serve the house at 408 Greenwood St without an aerial trespass over the property of 410 Greenwood St.

Wherefore it prays that after due notice and hearing as provided by law, it be granted a location for and permission to erect and maintain poles and wires, together with such sustaining and protecting fixtures as it may find necessary, said poles to be erected substantially in accordance with the plan filed herewith marked- Providence St, Grafton St, Riverlin St -Millbury-Massachusetts.
