- b. Any person wishing to speak must identify him or herself by name and address, and specific interest for wishing to speak.
- c. There will be a time limit of 3 minutes per person, which will be enforced by the Chair of the meeting.
- d. Comments should be limited to those items within the School Committee's scope of authority. The authority of the School Committee primarily concerns the review and approval of the budget of the district's public schools, the performance of the Superintendent, and the educational goals and policies of the district's public schools. Comments and complaints regarding school personnel (apart from the Superintendent) or students are generally prohibited unless those comments and complaints concern matters within the scope of School Committee authority.
- e. On those issues that can be resolved by directing citizens to the appropriate staff, the Superintendent or Chair will advise the citizen of appropriate steps to take.
