ARTICLE 2: COUNCIL ON AGING HVAC SYSTEM

To see if the Town will vote to repurpose the appropriation of \$14,000 voted under Article 6.14 at the May 2, 2017 Annual Town Meeting (originally for the purpose of painting the Council on Aging Building) for the purpose of repairing and/or replacing portions of the HVAC system at the Council on Aging Building and all costs incidental and related thereto, or take any other action thereon.

ARTICLE 3. PURCHASE OF CLEAR VIEW COUNTRY CLUB

Submitted by: Board of Selectmen

To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to exercise the Town's right of first refusal under Chapter 61B, Section 9, of the Massachusetts General Laws and purchase certain real property together with any improvements thereon known as the Clear View Country Club, located on Park Hill Avenue and identified on Assessors Map 22 as Parcel 2 and on Assessors Map 28 as Parcel 22, containing approximately 118 acres of land, under such terms and conditions as the Board of Selectmen may determine, to be held by the Board of Selectmen for general municipal purposes; and further, in order to fund said purchase and all costs incidental and related thereto, to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow, or otherwise provide the sum of \$3,100,000 and an additional sum necessary to complete the real estate transaction, or some other sum; and further, to authorize the Town Treasurer, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, to issue any bonds or notes that may be necessary to meet said appropriation in accordance with Chapter 44 of the Massachusetts General Laws, provided that any premium received upon the sale of any bonds or notes approved by this vote, less any such premium applied to the payment of the costs of issuance of such bonds or notes, may be applied to the payment of costs approved by this vote in accordance with Chapter 44, Section 20, of the Massachusetts General Laws, thereby reducing the amount authorized to be borrowed to pay for said purpose by a like amount; provided, however, that this appropriation and debt authorization shall be contingent upon passage of a Proposition 2½ debt exclusion referendum under Chapter 59, Section 21C(k), of the Massachusetts General Laws; or take any other action thereon.

Required Vote: Two-Thirds Majority
